For additional engine troubleshooting information, refer to the engine owner's manual.

| PROBLEM | SOLUTION |

| Engine will not crank. | Check battery connections and battery charge. check engine fuse (see section 6-4). |
| Engine will not start. | Check fuel supply. Check engine oil level. |
| Engine stops during operation. | Check engine oil level. |
| No AC generator output. | Reset thermal overload switches on generator panel if necessary. Check serpentine belt for soundness and tension. |
| Low AC voltage. | Check engine speed (see section 6-4). |
| No air compressor output. | Check position of manual unloader valve (see section 5-5). Check v-belts for soundness and proper tension (see section 6-4). |
| Engine will not throttle up for various functions. | Check position of manual unloader valve (see section 5-5). Check throttle fuse (see section 6-4). |
| Excessive moisture in the compressed air. | Drain water from air tank. |
| Gradual loss of engine power. | Check engine air and fuel filters. |
